Redoubtable is an old-fashioned type of thoroughbred with excellent conformation and straight moving expressive paces, an elegant horse, short coupled, deep chested, with a good length of rein, excellent feet and a beautiful head with a very kind eye. He is an impressive stallion with a superb attitude an excellent temperament and shows a bold, careful loose jump. His champion bloodlines link him to some of the top race horses of all time thus making him highly thought of by the racing world.

He first came to public stud in 2006 having been in training for 13 years and holds the record for the first fourteen year old to win a flat race in Great Britain since Be Hopeful in 1973. Having run 15 times in 2005 he had lost none of his incredible will to win, and is still as unblemished as the day he was born. How many ex-racing stallions would have the temperament, soundness, conformation and quality to embark on an in-hand career at 16 years of age?

A perfect gentleman at all times, we consider him to be a superb sire for top class show horses, show hunter ponies, working hunters, hacks, intermediates and event horses as well as top class race horses, point to pointers and polo ponies. The perfect sire to inject quality into heavier mares as well as giving thoroughbreds speed and stamina, his foals ooze presence and quality.

As a 2yr old he won at Chester by 5 lengths on his debut, he won The National Stakes listed race (beating subsequent Queen Mary winner Risky) was 3rd Norfolk Group 3, Royal Ascot to 2000 Guineas Group 1 winner Turtle Island. 3rd Group 1 Middle Park Stakes, beaten by a head and 5th Dewhurst Stakes Group 1, At 3yrs: 2nd John of Gaunt Stakes, 4th Cork and Orrey Stakes Group 3, Royal Ascot won 1 race, £2388. . UAE won 2 races placed three times. At 6 years, won 3 races and placed 3 times, £25,462.

Grey Dawn II (1962 horse by **Herbager**); Champion 2yr old in France in 1964; in France, **won** 4 races and placed twice at 2 years, **won** 2 races and placed twice at 3 years, won 6 races and placed 4 times, 888029 francs; in USA, **won** 2 races and placed once, \$20462 at 4 years; **won** Prix de la Salamandre, Longchamp, Gr.1, 1964, Prix Morny, Deauville, Gr.1, 1964, Grand Criterium, Longchamp, Gr.1, 1964, Brandywine Turf Handicap, Delaware Park, Gr.3, 1966, Prix de Fontainebleau, Longchamp, Gr.3, 1965, Prix de Beauvais, Longchamp, L., 1965; **second** in Poule d'Essai des Poulains, Longchamp, Gr.1, 1965, Prix de la Porte Maillot, Longchamp, Gr.3, 1965; **fourth** in Tidal Handicap, Aqueduct, Gr.2, 1966, Riggs Handicap, Pimlico, Gr.3, 1966. His daughter's have produced **Alphabatim**, **El Senior**, **Itsallgreetome**, **Opening Verse** and **Silver Patriarch**. Also the Sire of Sports Horse Stallion **Kuwait Beach**.

Redoubtable is the last son of **Grey Dawn II** at stud.

Seattle Rockette (USA) 1985 mare by **Seattle Slew** (USA); in USA, unplaced; dam of 8 known foals; 5 known runners; 5 known winners, exported to Japan as a broodmare, dam of 4 stallions. Half sister to **Prix Lupin** winner **Persepolis**.

2nd Dam **Perlita** dam of 5 winners inc Gr 1 winner **Persepolis**, dam of 2 stallions. 3rd Dam **Pola Bella** Champion 2 year old filly in France in 1967 2nd top rated 3 yr old filly 1968 Group 1 winner and dam of 3 stallions.

Seattle Slew (USA) (1974 horse by **Bold Reasoning** (USA)); Champion 2 and 3 year old in USA in 1976 and 1977.
